





With golden sands and safe shallow waters, Weymouth beach is a fun relaxing and safe place for the whole family to enjoy, so hire a deckchair or sun lounger, sit back and relax. There's plenty of entertainment for everyone, from traditional attractions such as Punch and Judy and donkey rides to lively events. For the more active, have a go at beach volleyball on the new permanent court or hire a bike and explore area on the new and improved cycle paths.



The distinctive curve of Weymouth Bay, outstanding Georgian architecture on the Esplanade and stunning World Heritage Jurassic Coast were just some of the images beamed around the world in 2012 as Weymouth successfully hosted the sailing events for the Olympic and Paralympic Games. Make a visit yourself and see first hand the many improvements to the town and seafront.

Regular or first time visitors to Weymouth will see a number of recent improvements to the town. Widened pavements on part of the Esplanade have created an ever popular Mediterranean style cafe culture whilst the new styled boardwalk beach cafes allow you enjoy a lazy lunch on the beach without getting sand in your shoes. New lighting gives the seafront a welcoming ambiance for your evening stroll, the floodlit tropical planting and colourful light columns brighten up the Esplanade, whilst the veils of light subtly light up the bay.

Just a few minutes away from the seafront is the 17C traditional working harbour which offers plenty to see and do all year round. See the historic town bridge lift and watch the sailing boats come and go or one of the local fishing boats land its daily catch. An abundance of fresh seafood is on offer in one of the many restaurants in and around the town.



There's a wide choice of attractions to visit whatever the weather, including Country Park's, major indoor attractions, cinema, or have a go at 10 pin bowling. The town centre is minutes from the main beach, where high street stores sit alongside quaint and specialist local shops.



As night approaches Weymouth comes alive with a new-found atmosphere. Many of the bars and clubs have various themed nights and host regular live music from some great local bands. Take a leisurely evening stroll along Weymouth's seafront and harbour making time for a glass of wine.
